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What to Do After Pool Coping Installation

When creating a new pool patio from brick or stone, the initial step is to install the coping. Since the coping sits directly at the edge of the pool, it is imperative that you adhere to the follow instructions in order to avoid complications with your pool. It is the responsibility of the homeowner to schedule for the pool to be power vacuumed after the coping installation. Basics Landscaping will not remove any amount of mortar that may fall into the pool.

If your coping installation is going to take place between March and May, there is the possibility that your pool will not be open yet. Basics will inform you of the installation date in order for you to either have the cover removed, or at least removed from the coping area. We can take the cover off for you, fold it and put it away if necessary.

Once the installation of the coping is complete, the pool must be cleaned within 24 - 48 hours. We highly recommend that you try to agitate any mortar with your pool brush in order to keep the mortar from hardening. This will help break up the mortar and facilitate the cleaning of the pool.

Due to the proximity of the coping installation, it is impossible to avoid any accumulation of debris in the pool. We try diligently to work as neat and cleanly as possible, but this is inevitable. Please remember to schedule your pool cleaning as soon as you receive your installation date. If you have any further questions, please address your foreman or call our office.

Cost of this procedure can vary based on size of pool, but usually is approximately \$100 per hour and this process usually takes about 2 hours for a 20' x 40 pool.
